

Welcome Fall Day Camp Families!

Check in and check out:

- Please park in the main parking lot. Check In and Out is in Arts and crafts (behind the office)
- It is important to sign your child in and out each morning and afternoon. Make sure you speak to a staff member so they are able to relay any information concerning your child or general program updates.
- Only people designated on the admission section of the sign in book may sign your child out.
- We get ready for activities at 9:00am. If you arrive after 9:15 and there is no one at the check-in area, you will be responsible to check in your child at the office and take your child to his or her first activity.
- Early bird begins no sooner than 7:30am. Night owl ends at 6:30 pm. Please plan accordingly. *You must sign up for early bird or night owl before the session begins.*
- **IF YOU NEED TO PICK UP YOUR CHILD EARLY** please tell a staff member in the morning. Sign your child out at the office and refer to the posted schedule to find out where your child is. **The office will give you a voucher to give to the staff member that lets them know you have already signed out.**
- A late fee of \$5/15 minutes will be charged if your child is picked up after their scheduled time. This fee will be deducted from your child's store account or is payable at the main camp office between 9am and 5pm.

Things to bring:

- Sun protection - hat, sunscreen, lip screen
- Layered clothes - all campers should have warm clothing for cooler weather. Coastal conditions can range from cool & overcast to warm & sunny in the same day!
- Bathing suits and rashguards should be brought **Tuesday & Thursday**, the scheduled days for water activities. The staff will inform you of any changes made due to weather or other conditions. ***** Note: we cannot allow campers to enter the water unless they have a towel and dry clothing to change back into.** Please send your child to camp in regular clothing since water time is in the afternoon. They will have an area to store a bag with their bathing suit and towel.
- Wetsuits are highly recommended for water activities. The weather and water can be quite cold at any time of the year!
- Wearing sandals is fine but please also send close-toed shoes for activities and games that require them for safety (ie climbing tower, group games, etc.).

Store Information:

- Campers visit the camp store each day after lunch to purchase snacks and souvenirs.
- Please deposit store money for the week with the Check In counselor.

Lunch/Snacks

- Lunch - We will provide lunch for all day campers
- Snacks - If you send a snack for 4:30, please limit it to one small item that is wrapped or sealed. You may also wish to provide a snack for early bird or night owls. We will have fruit available for the campers during those times.

General notes:

- Electronic games, music, and expensive or valuable items should not be brought to camp.
- Initials on clothing and towels will help us to match lost items with campers.
- Please check that your child has their belongings at the end of each day and check our Lost & Found area when you pick up your child on Friday.
- *The schedule may vary due to weather or other conditions.*
